GEORGE HARVEY LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Award

The Board of Management decided in 1992 to honour the hard work and dedication of George Harvey, the Association's first Life Member (1984). George is considered by many as the patriarch of Little Athletics in Queensland. He first became involved in 1975 and after gaining considerable experience at Centre Level moved onto the Queensland State Board of Management, serving as President from 1979 to 1989 and becoming a principal driving force behind the Association during its formative years. In 1989 he stepped down from that position to take on Presidency of the Australian Little Athletics Union, a position he held until April 1994. He was Chief Executive Officer of the QLAA from July 1993 until May 1996. In April 1996, he was honoured with the award of Life Membership of Australian Little Athletics.

The George Harvey Award is presented each year to one girl and one boy who best demonstrate they embrace the ideals of Little Athletics. The criteria encompasses those attributes George himself believes are important not only in Little Athletics but also to any individual's growth and development.

The Athlete

Eligibility for the award will **not** be restricted by athletic ability as demonstrated on the track and in the field. The athletes selected will have been regular attendees of Centre and Regional competitions and will have displayed a willingness to participate in the full range of Little Athletics events. They will have been involved in Little Athletics for a minimum of 5 years and will currently be in the U15 - U17 Age Groups.

Required Attributes

LEADERSHIP: Provides an example to others and shows a desire to assist in the

development of skills in others.

RESPECT: Is always courteous, shows regard for fellow athletes and officials and

accepts the judges' decisions.

PERSERVERENCE: Performs with determination to attain personal goals even if difficulties

and setbacks are encountered.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Abides by a code of fair play and is gracious in victory and defeat.

ENTHUSIASM: Irrespective of ability, displays a keenness to become involved in all

activities.

FINALLY: The athlete should have been an ambassador for little athletics, proud of

his/her involvement in the sport and have promoted it amongst his/her

peers.

All nominations must be accompanied by a copy of the Centre meeting minutes from which the recommendation for nomination was made, together with copies of your Centre's competition recording details (GameDay or Timing Solutions) for the athlete showing Centre level performances at ALL eligible meetings** whether nominated weeks or not.

**see Competition Eligibility

- Nominations must be made on the approved form (page 14 of this booklet).
- The winner will be announced and the Trophy presented at the State Championships each year.

Eligibility Period

SUMMER SEASON CENTRES Any ten (10) weeks from the first competition day of the Centre's

season to three (3) weeks prior to the State Championships.

WINTER SEASON CENTRES Any ten (10) weeks from the first competition day of the Centre's

season to the last competition day.

For all Centres, the actual ten (10) individual weeks are to be submitted with nominations, accompanied by a copy of the Centre recording sheets, by the due date. This allows for the required number of weeks to be selected at the end of the period, eliminating the problems caused by lost weeks, due to wet weather etc.

Competition Eligibility

- Open to Centre level competition only.
- This excludes Regional and Association days. Other InterCentre competition is eligible.

Eligibility Of Venues

Open to competitions held at all venues.

Note

Individual events for each age group are as indicated on the pink and blue achievement cards.

Event Groups

Sprints & Hurdles All Hurdles; 70m, 100m, 200m.

Middle Distance & Walks 400m, 800m, 1500m, 700m walk, 1100m walk, 1500m walk, 3000m walk,

and U7/8 200m

Throws Discus, Javelin, Shot Put

Jumps High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump.

Points Score

Points are to be awarded for exceeding personal bests on the basis of one point per event group per nominated week ie a maximum of four (4) points per athlete per nominated week. The point for a particular group can be scored for any event within the group however only one (1) point per group per nominated week can be scored. The number of nominated weeks is ten (10) therefore the maximum number of points possible during the eligibility period is forty (40).

Definition Of Personal Best

This is defined as the athletes <u>best performance</u> from <u>all</u> Centre level performances of the <u>current season</u>, prior to the first selected week of the 10 week period. Subsequent performances in the selected period should include progressive improved performances (each entry) from the initial best performance, recorded prior to the first week of the selected period. Each improved performance in each event group gains one (1) point.

Athletes who do not have a best performance prior to the selected 10 week period, the first performance of the period is to count as the best performance and entered at the top of the nomination form. <u>No</u> points can be gained from this performance.

Note:

The personal best details which are to be recorded at the top of the nomination form are for the athletes personal best at the start of the season. These are the performances on which all improvements are based.

Procedure For Drawn Result

In the case of a drawn result the award will be decided on the greatest number of individual events comprising the final score. If the result is still drawn the award is to be made at the discretion of the Board of Directors and this decision is final.
