

COVID PLANNING

Conditions of Entry

- All members must check-in using the EVA check-in/out code or by manually writing details on forms provided at the entry point.
- We recommend having smart devices charged and ready to scan an EVA code leading up to the entry point and at the exit.
- You will be required to verify that you have completed COVID check-in. Consider pre downloading the [EVA check-in app](#) to hasten your check-in process
- We strongly recommend that you allow ample time for parking and queuing for COVID check-in. Athletes should be ready to report to the Call Room or nominated event areas 20-30 minutes prior to the event's scheduled time.
- Entry to the competition spectator area will be through the dedicated entry point under the tunnel, which is located a little further up the ring road from the normal corner entry.
- If you are running a late, unaccompanied athletes in uniform will be allowed to enter the grounds to get to their event or Call Room through the dedicated entry or the exit point. Families can then regroup once parents/guardians etc. have checked at the dedicated entry point.
- The exit point is located at the corner gates (opposite the toilet block).
- Pass outs (collected at the exit point) will be available for persons who have already checked in. Return entry can be through the dedicated entry or the exit point.
- Anyone attending the Carnival must adhere to social distancing guidelines. LAQ COVID Officers will be on site.

LAQ will have sanitiser available however, it is advised to bring your own.

CALL ROOM (MARSHALLING)

Due to Council restrictions event calls cannot be announced prior to 8:00am.

- Athletes nominated in the 3000m & 1500m Race Walking Events, scheduled for 7:30am, must be at the Call Room by 7:00am.
- Athletes nominated in the 1100m Race Walking Events, scheduled for 8:00am, must be at the Call Room by 7:30am.
- Athletes nominated in the U10 Boys and Girls High Jump, scheduled for 8:10am, must be at the event areas by 7:50am

After 8:00am, listen for event calls, only one will be made for each event - for track events report to the Call Room, for field events report directly to the relevant event area.

The main Call Room will be operating at the start (northern) end of the arena under the orange Nordic Sports tents. A smaller Call Room may be utilised for athletes competing in events on or starting on the back straight.

An information area will not be operating.

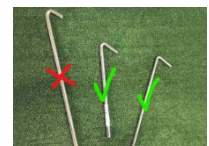
There will be a [cashless](#) canteen operating during the program times.

The grandstand will be open; however social distancing will apply, every other row must be left empty. Staff will be in the grandstand to ensure everyone is compliant.

Tents will be permitted on the grassed area surrounding the arena - heed signage and barricading. ONLY short tent pegs are to be used.

Tents must be established at least 1.5m from other tents. Social distancing guidelines must be followed for those under the tents.



We recommend that athletes bring their own water bottles - bubblers are for water bottle filling only!

U9 - U17 Placegetter medals will be awarded on the field at the conclusion of the event.

U9 - U17 Placegetter medals will be awarded at the conclusion of races once placing are confirmed.

U7 - U8s may collect participation medallions after their first event from the medal collection tent near the finish line.
